



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. A DEFINITE CALL TO MINISTRY

- * **Certificate of Ministry** – Call to Serve Under a Pastor in Local Church Ministry
- * **License or Ordination** – Call to the Five-fold Ministries or other Ministries
- * **Membership** – Only for Ministers Licensed or Ordained in a Denomination which does not permit them to be credentialed with RMFI
(Include a copy of the current credential with the application.)
- * **Church or Ministry Affiliation** – Churches/Ministries called together for covering, fellowship, and kingdom ministry purposes.

2. MINISTRY PREPARATION PROPORTIONAL TO THE CREDENTIAL

Preparation Options:

- * Training in a Bible College, School of Ministry, correspondence courses, etc., and/or equivalent personal study and ministry experience.
- * Redemption Leadership Development Center courses are available in Greenville and online for all ministers in the USA and internationally.
- * If formal training or equivalent personal study and ministry experience is not evident, a general Bible and Ministry Exam may be required.

3. ACTIVE SERVICE IN MINISTRY PROPORTIONAL TO THE CREDENTIAL

Level of Ministry Position/Experience will in part determine the level of Credential

4. APPLICATION FORM COMPLETED AND RETURNED

- * Submitted applications remain active for 90 days.
- * Incomplete applications (over 95 days active) will receive two follow-up contacts before the applicants file is placed in inactive status.

5. \$75 APPLICATION FEE

There will be a \$25 reactivation fee for applications placed in inactive status.

6. TWO RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE ENCLOSED FORMS:

- (1) Your current local church pastor or minister you are serving.
- (2) A person who has known you well for at least 3 years (a Minister, friend, employer, etc.). Important: Can Not Be a Family Member.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Recommendations must be turned in to RMFI directly by person completing the form.

7. COMMITMENT TO WALK IN AGREEMENT

Signed commitment on the Application to walk in agreement with the RMFI Leadership, Statement of Faith, Biblical standards for personal life and ministry, prayer and financial support, and participation in RMFI meetings and special events.
